

FALL FAIR RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Exhibits are limited to amateurs, backyard growers, home crafters etc. except for category 195 - local growers produce display
2. Entry forms can be submitted on line by Saturday 6pm. In person entry forms will be taken the Saturday 10am-1pm and Monday 9am-4pm before the exhibition at the Hall. **No entries will be accepted after 4pm Monday.**
3. Entry fees are by donation.
4. Submission of exhibits: Thursday before the exhibition
Paintings, photography and needle arts: 10am-noon. Children's exhibits: 10-noon.
All other divisions: 4-7pm
NO EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE INDICATED TIME
5. The Fall Fair Committee will place the exhibits
6. FallFair exhibits can not be picked up until after the Fair closes Sat 3-4pm.
7. The Agricultural Society will take all necessary precautions to protect exhibits but will not be liable for any loss, accident, damage or loss by any other cause.
8. Award ribbons will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category, providing that the exhibits merit the award (at the discretion of the judges). The decision of the judges is final in all cases. tinyurl.com/fall-fair-judging
9. Entries can not be combined by two or more exhibitors.
10. Entries of a similar nature may not be entered in more than one division or sub-section of a division.
11. All vegetables, fruit or flowers must have been grown by the exhibitor on Mayne Island.
12. The exhibition in the Hall will open at 10am-3pm.
13. The Fall Fair organizers reserve the right to not exhibit items deemed unsuitable for a family event.
14. Children (aged 15 and under) **MUST** enter exhibits in Division VI
